# General Information

## Case carriers

- At this time, will remain the same
- Following a hybrid schedule
- Will report to school 4 days a week to allow for support for Level 1 and Level 2 students
- May provide support at other grade levels if necessary

## Special education assistants

- Will report 4 days a week
- May provide support across grade levels

# General Information

- ❑ Level 1 students will continue to attend 4 days per week with a move from in-person support to in-person instruction
- ❑ Mondays will remain asynchronous; scheduled times will likely continue
- ❑ Schedule Changes
  - ❑ Tweaking the overall master schedule to account for staggered lunch/recess times
  - ❑ General education teachers and case carriers will share any schedule changes with families
- ❑ Classrooms
  - ❑ Grades K-2: Each co-teaching partnership is looking at the needs of each student to determine how best to group students in the “split” classrooms
  - ❑ Grades 3-5: Classrooms:students will remain in their current classroom assignments.

# Services

- ❑ Co-taught classrooms will be utilized as much as possible
  
- ❑ Concurrent Instruction
  - ❑ Case carriers may need to deliver instruction concurrently
  - ❑ Depends on the services of hybrid and virtual students
  
- ❑ Small Group Instruction
  - ❑ Special education students can be pulled into small groups for services
    - ❑ General education setting: with peers from the same classroom
    - ❑ Special education setting: with peers from other classrooms

# Services–continued

- ❑ **Current** sessions that occur between 2:20-4:00 can occur at school for hybrid students
  - ❑ Tuesday-Friday sessions/check-ins only
  - ❑ Parent must agree to the in-person after school time
  - ❑ Parent must provide transportation
  - ❑ Special education teacher will reach out to confirm schedule
  
- ❑ 1:1 Special Education Assistants
  - ❑ Students with an assigned 1:1 assistant will continue to have support in-person/virtually
  
- ❑ Related Services (OT, PT, Speech)
  - ❑ Provided via a virtual format
  - ❑ Case by case basis
  
- ❑ Information and guidance regarding recovery services will be coming

# Accommodations

- ❑ Movement Breaks
  - ❑ Opportunities to move about the building
  - ❑ Use outdoor spaces and courtyards
  - ❑ Gym at designated times
  
- ❑ Breaks
  - ❑ Scheduled & unscheduled
  - ❑ Classroom spaces available
  
- ❑ Masks
  - ❑ Students are required to wear masks unless medically exempt
  - ❑ Medical mask exemptions are confidential information
