A Day In the Life of a Slider (Virtual)

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade

- Virtual learning to continue
- Grade level collaborative learning teams (CLTs) will continue to meet and plan instruction
- Continued use of Canvas, Seesaw, Dreambox, RAZ Kids, etc
- Adjustment of lunch/recess schedule to align with hybrid
- May be some adjustments to the overall schedule
- Specials will be virtual and synchronous
- Movement breaks will be scheduled by teacher
- Week of February 23 & March 2 time spent building new relationships

A Day In the Life of a Slider (Virtual)

3rd-5th Grade Concurrent Teaching Model

- ❑ The teacher will be working with students in person and at home simultaneously
- ❑ There are various models for how this can work
 - ❑ Whole group lesson
 - ❑ Small group lessons--station rotation
- ❑ Teacher will be working to monitor student questions and responses whether in person or at home
- ❑ Specialists assigned to provide classroom support for additional assistance

A Day In the Life of a Slider (Virtual)

3rd-5th Grade Concurrent Teaching Model

- ❑ Continued use of Canvas, Seesaw, Dreambox, RAZ Kids, etc
- ❑ Adjustment of lunch/recess schedule to align with hybrid
- ❑ Art and Music will be taught virtually to all virtual/hybrid students
- ❑ PE will be primarily taught virtually in concurrent classes with the exception of the classroom teachers who report Tuesday-Friday

Screening & Arrival

- ❑ Complete the Qualtrics Health Screener
 - ❑ Email/text link sent each morning by 5:00am
 - ❑ Must be done prior to coming to school or boarding the bus
 - ❑ You will receive confirmation email/text that you are cleared and will need to show at school/bus
 - ❑ Temperature screening done at Bus/School
- ❑ Arrival
 - ❑ PreK-2, Siblings: 8:40 am
 - ❑ Grades 3-5: 8:50am

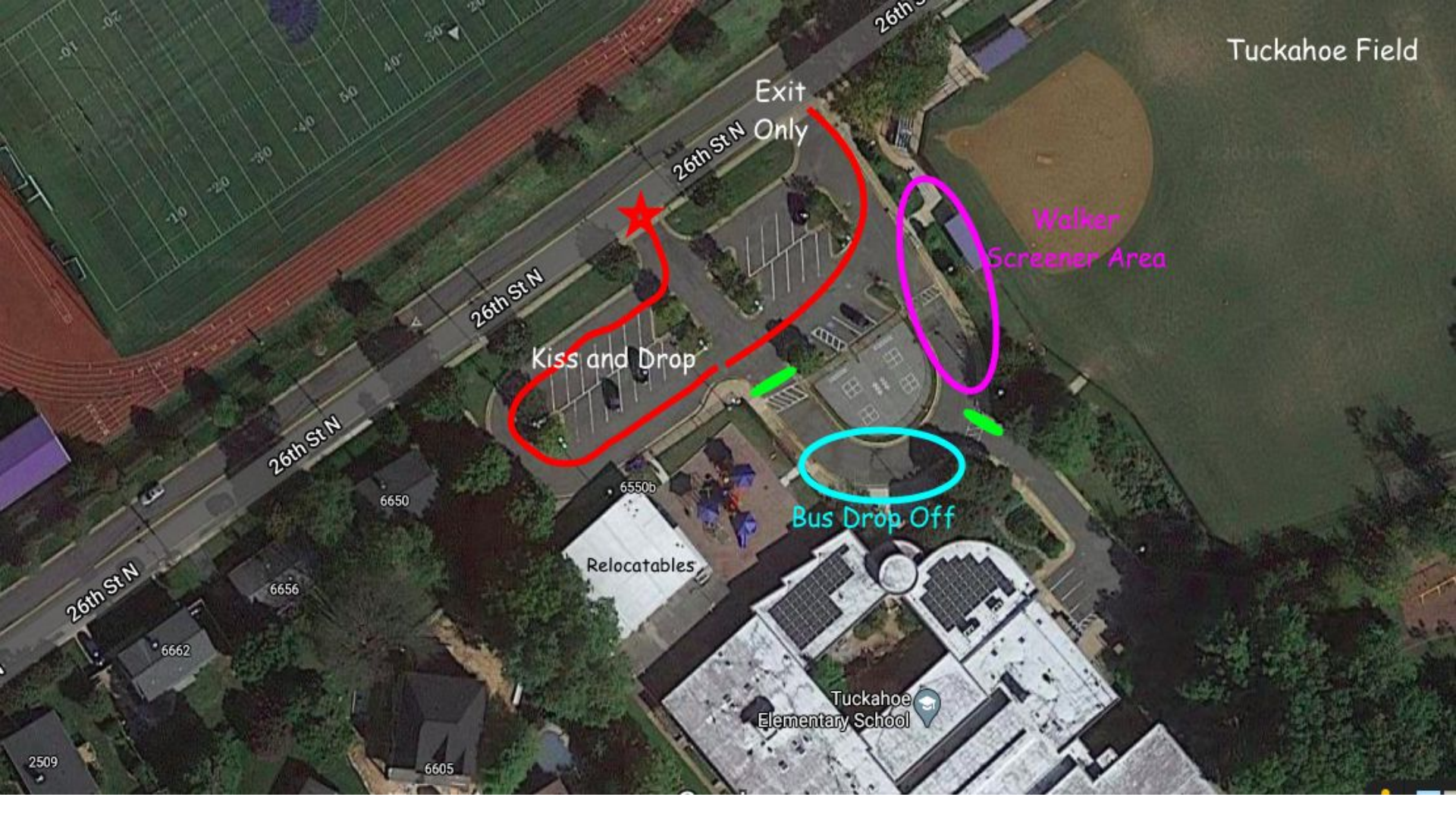

Screening & Arrival

- ❑ We will operate (2) temperature screening areas:
 - ❑ Kiss and Ride
 - ❑ Have screener email/text ready
 - ❑ Do not exit car until told to do so
 - ❑ If you notice long Kiss and Ride line, please consider parking and escorting your child to the “walker” area
 - ❑ Walker Arrival
 - ❑ Have screener email/text ready
 - ❑ Parents will not be permitted past the arrival area
 - ❑ An adult must bring your child to school and stay with child until screened
- ❑ Students will proceed directly to their classrooms upon entering the building with staff support

Classrooms,

Snack, Lunch & Recess

- ❑ Recess
 - ❑ One classroom per playground
 - ❑ Front playground, field, Tuckahoe Park on a grade level rotating schedule
 - ❑ K-2 classrooms that are split for instructional time will join together
 - ❑ 10 feet of distancing
- ❑ Recess Times
 - ❑ PreK: 10:30-11:00
 - ❑ K: 11:20-11:50
 - ❑ 1: 11:20-11:50
 - ❑ 2: 12:00-12:30
 - ❑ 3: 12:00-12:30
 - ❑ 4: 12:40-1:10
 - ❑ 5: 1:20-1:50

Dismissal

- ❑ All families who are picking up students will park and pick up their children from a designated location

- ❑ Grade K-1 students must be picked up by adult or met at the bus stop

- ❑ Grades 2-5 are permitted to walk home/ leave bus stop without an adult

- ❑ Staggered dismissal times
 - ❑ 2:20: PreK & Siblings
 - ❑ 2:25: Grades K, 1, 2
 - ❑ 2:30: Grades 3, 4, 5

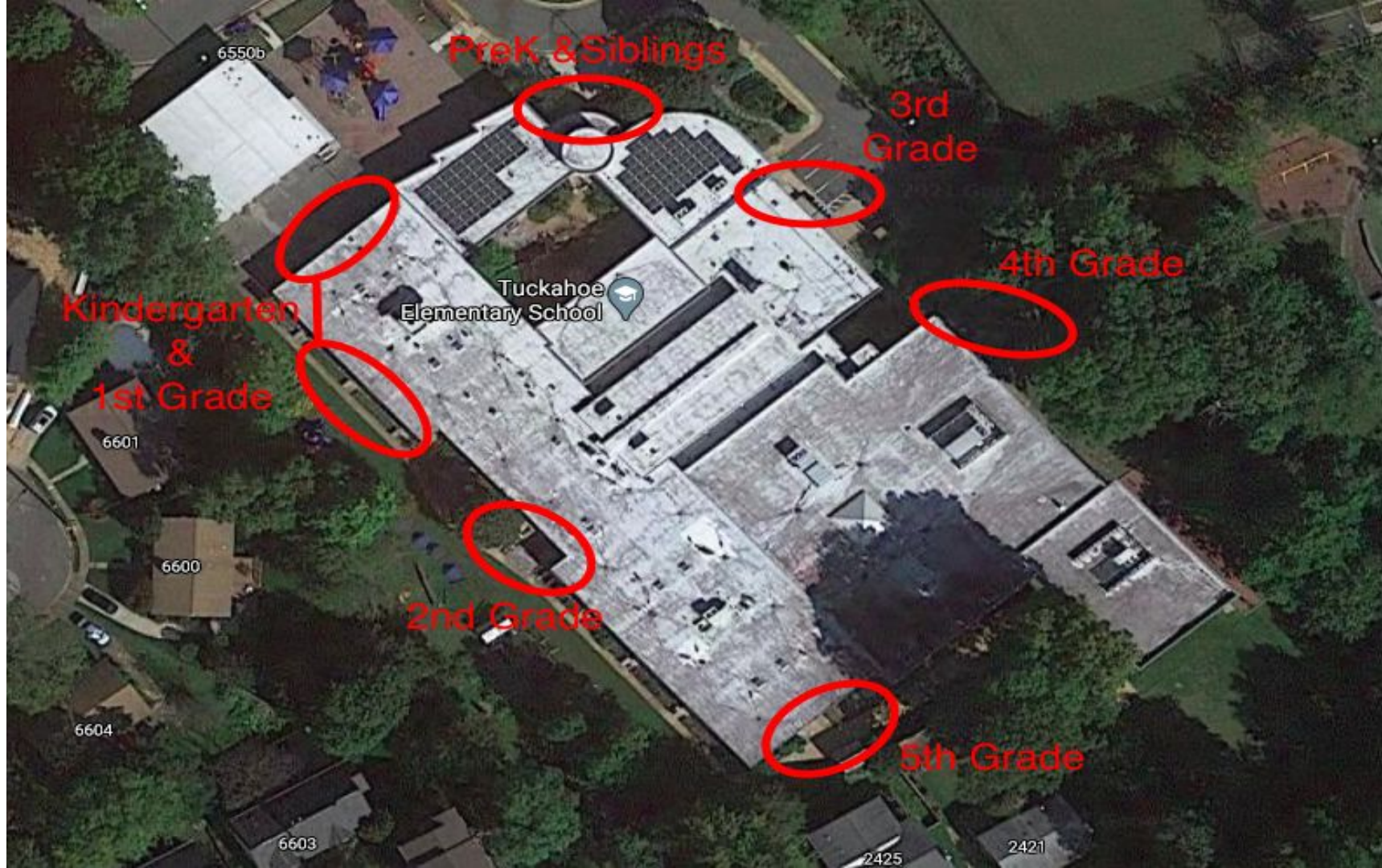

Dismissal

- ❑ Designated Locations
 - ❑ PreK: Door 1
 - ❑ Siblings: Door 1
 - ❑ Kindergarten: Classrooms/Door 9
 - ❑ 1st Grade: Classrooms/Door 9
 - ❑ 2nd Grade: Door 8
 - ❑ 3rd Grade: Door 2
 - ❑ 4th Grade: Door 4
 - ❑ 5th Grade: Classrooms/Door 7

- ❑ Buses will depart as soon as possible
 - ❑ Routes are still being finalized
 - ❑ Be prepared for delays, especially the first few weeks
